Employment Status

Employer

A person who operates a business, a plantation or other trade and employs one or more workers to help him.

Government employee

A person who works for a public employer and receives regular remuneration in wages, salary, commission, tips or payment in kind

Private employee

A person who works for a private employer and receives regular remuneration in wages, salary, commission, tips or payment in kind

Unpaid family worker

A person who works without pay or wages on a farm, business or trade operated by another member of the family

Own account worker

A person who operates his own farm, business or trade without employing any paid workers in the conduct of his farm, trade or business

Concept and definitions: Informal sector

The informal sector comprises informal enterprise that meet the following criteria:

All or at least one goods or services are meant for sale or barter transactions.

The enterprise is not registered with the Companies Commission of Malaysia (CCM) or any professional bodies, including the Local Authority (LA).

Employment size is less than 10 persons and is not registered under stipulated national legislation.

















The Malaysia Standard Classification of Occupations (MASCO) is a national benchmark for classification of occupations in the employment structure of the country. The MASCO 2013 is based on International Standard Classification of Occupations (ICSO-08) with changes and modifications to meet the needs of the country. 
