










METHODOLOGIES & GUIDELINES

DOSM applied internationally recommended frameworks and manuals in the implementation of official statistical activities such as Generic Statistical **Business Process** Model (GSBPM), the Capacity Development 4.0 Matrix (PARIS21), National Framework Quality Framework Assurance (NQAF), Data Documentation Initiative (DDI) which is a platform for describing metadata and the Statistical Data and Metadata Exchange (SDMX) for standardisation and dissemination of statistical information at the international level.


























