# Newsletter Consumer Price Index (CPI) November 2014

## Inflation Rate for November 2014 is 3.0%

## The Consumer Price Index

The Consumer Price Index (CPI) measures the change over time in the general price level of goods and services that households acquire for the purpose of consumption, with reference to the price level in 2010, the base year, which has an index of 100.

## November 2014 rate of inflation

The year-on-year inflation rate as measured by the CPI stood at 3.0 percent in November 2014, up by 0.2 percentage point from the 2.8 percent recorded in October 2014 (Table 1). This rate of inflation for November 2014 shows how much higher or lower prices when compared with the same month a year earlier.

The monthly change rate for November 2014 was 0.5 percent compared to October 2014.

## Food and non-food inflation

The Food and non-alcoholic beverages group recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of 2.9 percent. This is 0.1 percentage point higher than the 2.8 percent recorded in October 2014. Three subgroups of the food and non-alcoholic beverages group recorded inflation rates higher than the group's average rate of 2.9 percent (Figure 1).




Figure 2: Year-on-year Non Food Inflation (%) by main groups, November 2014

The non-food group recorded a year-on-year inflation rate of 3.1 percent in November 2014, compared to the 2.7 percent recorded in October 2014. Five subgroups recorded year-on-year inflation rates higher than the group's average rate of 3.1 percent (Figure 2). Alcoholic beverages & tobacco recorded the highest rate of 10.5 percent followed by Transport with 5.0 percent; Restaurants and hotels (4.3 percent); Housing, water, electricity, gas and other fuels (3.5 percent); and Health (3.4 percent).

Inflation was lowest in the Furnishings, Household Equipment & Routine Household Maintenance subgroup (0.8%). On the other hand, Clothing & footwear and Communication subgroups recorded negative year-on-year inflation rates.

#### State differentials


At the state level, the year-on-year inflation rate ranged from 1.6 percent in the Sabah & Wilayah Persekutuan Labuan to 3.6 percent in Johor, Selangor & Wilayah Persekutuan Putrajaya. Four states (Selangor & Wilayah Persekutuan Putrajaya, Johor, Wilayah Persekutuan Kuala Lumpur and Pulau Pinang) recorded inflation rates above the national average of 3.0 percent (Figure 3).

#### Dissemination


